Does your article meet the aims and scope of the journal you are submitting to?	<input type="checkbox"/>

Have you prepared a PDF of the complete manuscript?	<input type="checkbox"/>
Do you know the peer review model for the journal you are submitting to? If single blind then your PDF of the complete manuscript will need to contain the names and institutes of authors at the start of the text. Figures and tables also need to be included within the text. If double blind then you'll need to anonymise your manuscript .	<input type="checkbox"/>
Is your article clearly written, concise and accessible? To help with this you can use IOP Editing Services .	<input type="checkbox"/>
Do you know the names, email addresses and affiliations of all co-authors (if less than 20)?	<input type="checkbox"/>
Have you listed all references you've used and in the correct format? Check our style guide for help and the journal guidelines if you are unsure.	<input type="checkbox"/>
Have you clearly cited any adapted/reproduced material in your figure/table captions? Any necessary permissions for reused material will need to be obtained before the acceptance stage.	<input type="checkbox"/>
Have you prepared any figures you've used in the correct format and to a high quality? IOP Editing services can help with Figure preparation	<input type="checkbox"/>
Do you have any supplementary data/material to include with the submission?	<input type="checkbox"/>
Have you considered the ethical policy for the journal you are submitting too? If your manuscript contains experimentation involving humans or animals, or containing images of people, you will need to ensure you have obtained the required consent	<input type="checkbox"/>
Have you considered the research data policy for the journal you are submitting to?	<input type="checkbox"/>
